### Yes Please:

- ✓ Clean and reusable items—clothing, paired shoes, books, CDs & DVDs, small electricals (e.g. hairdryers, toasters), pans and crockery
- ✓ Small items of furniture—please book a collection

### No Thanks:

- ✗ Dirty and damaged items
- ✗ Sharp items such as knives
- ✗ Duvets, pillows and bedsheets
- ✗ Toiletries and laundry items
- ✗ General waste
- ✗ Food—donate this to our food collection instead

## Where to Donate Blue Bags:

**Door to Door Collections: 16th, 23rd and 30th June**

Place your donations in the blue bag outside your front door by midday (12 noon) on our collection days. You can place two additional bags of items out for collection if packaged in clear strong bags. If you have more than three bags of donations or small items of furniture to donate, book a collection by emailing [sustainability@leeds.ac.uk](mailto:sustainability@leeds.ac.uk)

Alternatively, drop off your blue bag donations to one of our donation points. Food donations are also accepted, but food must be placed in a separate bag or box from your other donations.
